The Amalfi Coast and its impressive scenery are a treasure chest of wonders; every time you visit it surprises you with new enticing experiences.

Sailing along the Pathway of the Gods

Amalfi Coast - Capri

Our mini-cruise begins in the **MAIORI** area where you will embark aboard our **GOZZO**, a boat typical of the Amalfi Coast. Once settled on the boat, we will enter **PANDORA'S GROTTO**, see the nearby **MARMORATA FALLS**, and catch

a glimpse of the so-called city of music, the town of **RAVELLO** which is seated on a cliff high above the Amalfi Coast.

Encircling the cliff we will be able to see the **MARINE REPUBLIC OF AMALFI**, **SANTA CROCE** beach, home to the famous **LOVER'S ARCH**, and then the small village of **CONCA DEI MARINI**, where you have the option to visit the **EMERALD GROTTO**.



Sailing west we approach **FURORE FJORD**, a deep inlet where the International Diving Championships are held annually. The next village that we'll see is **PRAIANO**, a favorite destination of aristocratic Amalfitani during the Middle Ages. Here we will point out the famous night club **AFRICANA**, unique throughout the world for being built on top of a

natural grotto.

After a few minutes of sailing along the coast we will see **POSITANO** off in the distance. You have the option of disembarking here later in the afternoon. Just in front of Positano lie the mythical islands of **LI GALLI**, where, legend states, Ulysses had to tie himself to the mast of his ship in order to resist the singing of the sirens.

• **EMERALD GROTTO**: You will disembark our boat in order to explore the grotto for approximately 20 minutes in a smaller row boat.

• **BLUE GROTTO**: from our boat you board a tiny row boat that comes up along side and takes you inside the grotto.

Entrance fees for the Emerald Grotto and Blue Grotto are not included in the price of the minicruise. These excursions are optional and possible only with favorable weather conditions.

Before reaching **PUNTA CAMPANELLA**, where the **AMALFI COAST** officially ends and the **SORRENTO COAST** begins, we will come upon the small fishing village of **NERANO**, known for its first-class restaurants along the

beach. You may choose to stop here and savor delicious local dishes.

The excursion continues with a tour around the island of **CAPRI** with the possibility of visiting the famous **BLUE GROTTO***, enjoying an unforgettable swim among the **FARAGLIONI** rocks, and seeing the **WHITE** and **GREEN GROTTO**s. Furthermore, you have the option of disembarking for three hours to spend some time shopping on **CAPRI**.



Given a stop of your choice of circa three hours in either **POSITANO**, **NERANO** or **CAPRI**, we estimate a return time of approximately 6 pm.
